

## Focus Group Procedures


#### Purpose

- To gather information from the community's perspective on how to promote walking in a highcrime, urban area.
- Focus group questions were derived from the Social Ecological Model.
  - Individual characteristics
  - Interpersonal characteristics
  - Environmental characteristics




## **Study Population**

- Adults
  - 61 Adults (age 18 65 years)
  - 72% were female
  - 33% spoke Spanish, 18% spoke Nepali, 25% spoke Burmese, 8% spoke Arabic, and 16% spoke English
- Youth
  - 63 children (ages 6 17 years)
  - 57% were male; 43% female
  - 48% Hispanic, 24% African American, 3% Caucasian, 25% Other (mostly refugee population)




## Focus Group Questions


- Think about the last time you walked in the neighborhood.

- Does the school encourage children to walk or bike to school?




### **Overall Reported Barriers to PA**



#### Major Themes for Barriers to PA





## What Vickery Meadow community members are saying:

#### Youth


- The lights are confusing? I do not know which one to walk with...
- Sometimes you jaywalk because there are not good crosswalks
- If there is a crossing guard, then I'll walk there, but if there isn't I will jaywalk
- The bridges, the sidewalks are very, like small...a family can't walk like this...have to go out to the street




## What Vickery Meadow community members are saying:

#### Adults

- They run when they cross the street...because cars are so fast and never stop...never end
- There's no sidewalks, a lot of places no sidewalks
- Sometimes an apartment is not constructed or something like that...you can see the holes
- There is a hole in the fence
- The light is not working for cross walks




### **Specific Security Barriers**




#### Youth

- You see the drunks...get a feeling some drunk is going to do something to you
- People are watching you or following you
- I think they were gang members following...I felt scared
- Sometimes the lights don't work
- You can't see
- On the way home there are a lot of people who are on drugs




#### Adults


- Every time I go with my kids outside, I do not feel safe and the gait is always open
- They do not do nothing to protect us...
- The lighting on the streets are dull, they are not bright...
- *Outside by the road...they are doing drugs behind there*
- Someone was hitting and kicking the door
- It is very scary and risky to walk
- I feel every moment that somebody will do something bad to me...be careful all the time
- They snatch whatever we have from our pockets...




### Total Reported Solutions to Increasing PA








### **Specific Environmental Solutions**




#### Adults

- Sidewalks make it easier to walk
- Something to post...about where to cross
- People need to know about how to...push the button




#### Youth

- Have more traffic lights
- Fix the sidewalks so you don't fall
- Better sidewalks would make it easier to have strollers
- Trying to get to the park...more sidewalks and crosswalks
- Change the landscaping
- More trees for shade
- Feel safer if there was not as much graffiti around




## **Specific Security Solutions**




#### Adults

- I want protection when I walk, I want to safely
- So people that do not live there cannot get in
- Around this area, there is not as much policeman...sometimes it is...making sure children get home safely
- Mornings there is not a lot, but in the night there is
- If they have more cameras it would be easier
- More lamps because some streets are dark



- Youth
  - In the morning, there is no light...it is dark in the mornings
  - If we had more cameras then you would feel safer
  - More cameras would be good because teachers can't see everything
  - We need to have more light because people who are driving, they can't see people
  - Would you have more security guards?- Yes



## Take Home Message

- The majority of participants walk in VM to meet daily living needs
  - Mostly during daytime hours

- Most common barriers reported were security followed by environmental:
  - Children report more environmental related barriers to PA
  - Adults report more security related barriers to PA
- Most common solutions were security related followed by environmental solutions.
  - Children suggested more environmental solutions than adults

### Implementation of Improvements

- These findings in combination with a walkability led to the following improvements:
  - Repairs to crosswalks, traffic lights, and street lanes
  - Installing stop signs, speed limit signs, and lighting around schools
  - Construction of walking path
  - Creation of peer-walking groups
