2014 Awards Review Process

Update from Chair: Potential Collaboration with Anne Berman

The ISBM ETCD chair, Dr. Anne Berman, approached the SBM ETCD council to see if they would be interested in helping coordinate the creation of a MOOC (Massive Open Online Course) and help figure out a way to make it internationally available. Dr. Berman has piloted a few small international courses with positive feedback. Dr. Zarrett summarized her initial meeting with Anne, and asked council members if they knew of any models or had ideas that might help. Council members suggested reaching out to Jamie Bodenlos, who is involved with the ETCD Teaching Behavioral Medicine pre-conference course for 2014, and also suggested that staff research and review online visitors to the SBM online syllabi program. That may lead us toward finding SBM members that are actively teaching and creating lesson plans who would likely be a good fit for this effort.
