2015 membership update

New and renewing member applications, invoices, and online websites have been updated for 2015. 2015 membership should open this month. Ms. Bullock reported the Executive Committee voted October 23 to increase 2015 dues for full, fellow, and associate members to \$299 from \$287. It is the first dues increase since 2010.

Membership survey update

Drs. Baskin and Mama with input from other council members (e.g., Dr. Ledoux) and input from the Executive Committee have been refining the draft survey. Marian Fitzgibbon, PhD, and Amy Yaroch, PhD, should be providing input to Dr. Baskin shortly.

Membership brochure

The council remains committed to updating the society's membership brochure from its current 2013 version, to make the brochure more engaging and user-friendly with pictures that portray more diversity. The updated brochure can be used at SBM's annual meetings or can be sent to/left at other meetings or exhibits. Dr. Dulin Keita already made edits and selected new photos. Ms. Bullock will include those and other updates in a new brochure version to be ready for council review on the next call.

Membership video contest

The council expressed interest in moving forward with a video contest about SBM membership. The contest is seen as a way to raise awareness about SBM while encouraging member engagement. It may also help SBM get more member renewals for 2015.

The contest will be held in January 2015 to coincide with the start of a new membership year and to avoid overlapping with the annual meeting poster presenter video contest. The contest will ask people to upload YouTube or Vine videos
